

4 Watches of Prayer Instructions

Definitions:

- 1) Three things important to building prayer walls (pg. 86)
 - i) Rule
 - ii) Structure
 - iii) Assignment
- 2) Assignment of watchmen is to be the eyes and ears of the city.
- 3) Watchtower – observatory set up for military purposes (pg. 100)

Types of Intercessors:

- 4) Watchmen
 - i) Watch – Greek –gregoreuo or agrupneo (to stay awake, be vigilant, watch, pray, and sleep less)
 - ii) Watchmen will be responsible for opening and closing the call.
 - iii) Chief watchmen will have the oversight of the prayer call or prayer meeting – responsible for getting prayer targets for the call
 - iv) Power of intercession is behind the scenes belongs to watchmen
- 5) Gatekeepers – types of intercessors that control who goes in and out of the city – gatekeepers maintain the prayer call and keep order – may also receive prophetic insight, revelation. Gatekeepers are next in rank to the watchmen.
- 6) Porters - gatekeepers – we will set up chief porters to man the watches to control traffic on the calls and in our cities.

Instructions for Prayer Calls:

1. Have your prayer targets listed before you pray. Create your own, but please agree with us on the prayer points that will be given to the Commander of the Morning on a weekly basis.
2. Be prepared for prophetic insight from God as you pray, and make a listing to use in your prayer time. (Have pen and paper available)
